Dear Board Members, Counsel, and Staff,

The undersigned write in support of Petitioners’ Request for Reconsideration of Rulemaking Decision of the State Water Resources Control Board (“Board”) Denying Petition to Review and Revise the Bay-Delta Water Quality Standards and urge the Board to grant the Petition. Pursuant to its authority and mandate, the Board must address its statutory duty to review the Bay-Delta Plan every three years under the federal Clean Water Act and California’s Porter-Cologne Act; conduct meaningful government-to-government consultation on the Bay-Delta Plan update under Assembly Bill 52; and initiate a rulemaking to regulate and restructure Bay-Delta water rights in order to prevent unreasonable use of water and protect public trust resources. Given the decades long crisis in the Bay-Delta, the Board must act now in order to protect the Delta waterways and public health and safety of members of the Delta community.
